## Pioneer Lake Residential Association Hunting Regulations Updated 12/2/19

- 1. Obey all State of Alabama hunting and fishing laws.
- 2. Signing IN and OUT for all hunting is required (Signing Out is very important as to allow others to hunt in zones at a later time).
  - a. A hunting release must be signed by each hunting member and should be held on file with the board.
  - b. Guests must sign a release form.
  - c. Sign in and hunt by designated hunting zones (see map).
  - d. Sign in regardless if you hunt your individual lot or on common zones.
  - e. Sign up is first come/first served.
  - f. Sign up occurs after you arrive at Pioneer for your hunt.
  - g. No one can sign in another person.
- 3. No hunting is allowed on other members lots without their permission
- 4. No hunting is allowed inside the perimeter road (around the lake) with exception of lots 1-6. The lots 1-6 should not have established fixed stands within 100 ft. of shore and guns can only be fired away from the lake.
- 5. Rifle hunting is restricted to deer season only and fixed location using an elevated stand. **Stalk** hunting with a rifle is not allowed.
- 6. Hunting guests must be accompanied by an owner or an owner's family member that is at least 21 years of age.
- 7. Guests are allowed to hunt one of the common zones. The combination of members, immediate family and guests are limited to two common locations per day.
- 8. **Hunter's orange is required** for hunting during Gun deer season on all sites including private property.
  - *a.* It is recommended that non-hunters also wear orange for outside activities during deer season.
- 9. No use of firearms is permitted inside the perimeter road or on the lake except to shoot snakes or other varmint (also refer to #4).
  - a. Please use the designated range for target practice.
  - b. No target practice or use of the range is allowed during hunting hours.
  - c. Hours for target practice or use of the range are 9am to 6pm or earlier (than 6pm) if there is insufficient light.
- 10. No vehicles should be driven in and around the hunting areas during the hunting hours of deer and turkey season except for those hunters going to and from hunting locations.
  - a. Use of 4-wheelers, outside the perimeter road, for other than direct hunting activity is prohibited at Pioneer Lake during hunting (deer and turkey) season.
  - b. Please be attentive to the areas where hunters have signed in and choose the most appropriate route as not to disturb the hunting in those zones.
- 11. Any bucks taken should be minimum of 6 points with rack outside the ears. Please log all wildlife you have taken in the logbook at the sign in area.
- 12. No drinking alcoholic beverages is allowed prior or during hunting.
- 13. Drug use other than medicines prescribed by a physician is prohibited on any common areas on Pioneer Lake.
- 14. No hunting is allowed on Lot 7 as voted on by the membership effective October 2018.

## FAILURE TO FOLLOW THESE RULES SUBJECT THE GUEST OR THE MEMBER RESPONSIBLE TO SANCTIONS BY THE MEMBERSHIP INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMTIED TO LOSS OF HUNTING PRIVILEGES, FINES AND OTHER RESTRICTIONS AT PIONEER LAKE.
